



Thank you for taking a minute to support your school... register for the Pupil Premium now!

If you have a child in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2, please support your school by taking a few minutes to register for the Pupil Premium if your child is eligible.



What is the Pupil Premium?

The Pupil Premium is an extra amount of money paid direct to your school for every child, in any year, who is eligible for a Free School Meal.

The Pupil Premium is aimed at improving standards for children with families on lower incomes. Children who have been adopted from care are also eligible.

How is Pupil Premium money used by the school?

The government pays the money for Pupil Premium to the school and the headteacher decides the best way to spend it.

There's a lot of research which schools use to decide how to use the money, for example on smaller teaching groups, improving pupils' reading and writing skills or running social skills groups. Schools use the money in a variety of ways, and that could include employing additional staff.

We believe that this money can make a big difference to your child's education; in 2015-16 your school will receive up to £1,320 for each child eligible and £1,900 for each child who is adopted. So, please register now so your school doesn't miss out!

Am I eligible?

- You will need to be in receipt of one of the following benefits:
- income support
- income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit (provided you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190, as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs).
- during the initial roll out of the benefit, Universal Credit

Anyone entitled to Working Tax Credit is not entitled to Pupil Premium regardless of income.



What do I need to do?

It's easy. Just complete the registration form overleaf and hand in to your child's school. If you're eligible we won't need to contact you, the funds will be paid direct to the school.
