Our main objectives:

At High Cliff Academy we aim to provide a range of sporting opportunities for our children. Our aspiration is to provide high quality sports education for all of our students, improving their health and fitness and promoting an inclusive ethos, where all students enjoy participating in sporting activities.

Our Sports Grant will be used to:

- Develop the practice of our teachers in the teaching of PE by employing a PE specialist to deliver support to teachers.
- Develop our sporting facilities by putting in a mile run track on the field so that the mile run is an embedded part of the curriculum.
- Develop our playground to encourage children to take part in games and activities during lunch and play times.
- Ensure that equipment is safe, practical, usable and in a good condition.
- Ensure every child has the opportunity to take part in a sporting activity/PE and not accepting pupils not having a PE kit as an excuse not to take part. Buy pupils PE kit where needed (PP pupils)
- Provide an opportunity to showcase our sporting talents to our parents and staff (Sports Day).
- Project a positive image of the Academy when competing against other schools. Focussing on team spirit, good sportsmanship and positivity. (COVID-19 dependent)
- Continue to develop the practice of current teachers in the teaching of healthy lifestyles.
