

Art: We will be using different grade pencils to produce observational drawings of plants. We will learn about Monet and use his beautiful paintings as an inspiration for our own.

Whole Class Reading: We will be reading a wide range of different traditional tales.

Phonics: We will be learning all of the different spellings for the 'igh', 'oul' and 'u'.

Geography: We will be focusing on weather and understanding geographical similarities and differences of a small area of the United Kingdom and of a small area in a contrasting non European country.

Science: We will be using our science skills of observation and classification to look closely at plants in our environment. We will be asking questions such as "What is a weed?" and "What do plants need to grow?" We will be investigating plants in our environment and growing different types of plants.

Personal, Social and Health Education: We will be learning focusing on 'Keeping Safe' and exploring the key question: 'Who helps to keep us safe?'

Religious Education: In RE, we will be focussing on Judaism and religious leaders. We will be exploring key leader qualities and Moses life.

Maths: We will be looking at beginning to tell the time to the hour and half past the hour and drawing the hands on a clock face to show these times. We will then explore multiplication and division using concrete objects.

Fantastic Flora

Computing: We will be seeing the potential of what computing can do by looking at time-lapse videos. We will be using QR codes on the Ipad's to carry out research. We will also be logging on to the computers, opening documents, and saving documents.

P.E: Our topic will be Athletics, we will be exploring running at different speeds, performing a variety of throws with basic control and standing long jump.

English: We will be comparing different traditional tales, looking at their similarities and differences. After this, we will read 'Jack and the Beanstalk' and write our very own version. In our writing, we will focus on using conjunctions such as 'and', 'but' and 'so' as well as different types of punctuation.
