

Languages

We will continue with our explorations into the French language this term, looking at key vocabulary and grammar and comparing it to English to see the patterns.

DT

This term, the Stingrays will be learning how to make a package for something delicate. We will research, design and make a product and then evaluate it to see if it has met our design brief.

Science

This term is our second term learning all about plants. We will be looking at the inside of plants closely and learning how they reproduce. We'll be doing this by learning all about the different organs inside the plants and about how seeds are dispersed. We will also continue to monitor the beans that we planted last term!

English

Our key text this term for reading and writing will be 'The River Singers' by Tom Moorhouse. This is a story of a journey away from danger to a safe place. This will support our context of natural forces and help us to learn about rivers. We will also be reading 'When the Giant Stirred' by Celia Godkin to help us understand that pictures are just as important as text to tell a story.

Forces of Nature

Geography

We will be learning about the forces of nature, from volcanoes and earthquakes, to rivers and the water cycle. Through discussion and practical tasks, we will be learning about, how and why these natural phenomena occur and the ways in which they affect people and the environment.

Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education

Our PSHE focus this term is health and well being. We will be learning about what it takes to keep us physically healthy. We will be learning about how and why we should practice good oral hygiene and about what kind of diet is best for us.

Religious Education

This term our Key Stage 2 religion of focus is Judaism. We will be learning all about how and where it is practiced and the main beliefs underpinning the religion.

Physical Education

This term we will be learning to play invasion games. We will be building on skills learnt in unihoc like team-work; co-ordination; ball skills; manipulation; and tactical strategies by learning the team game, rounders.

Maths

We will continue learning about multiplication and division this term, moving on to formal written calculations. This will prepare the children for working on long division and multiplication when they move to year 4. We will also be revisiting fractions, addition and subtraction before learning any new content to ensure that the children are confident with their number skills. We will continue learning our 3, 4 and 8 times tables to help us.
